HARRIET TUBMAN & THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD

(Eastern Shore MD.)

This guided tour introduces you to the life and legacy of Harriet Tubman. Here she was born and enslaved until age 27 when she escaped to freedom. Visit the Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad State Park. Travel along Blackwater Refuge to see the terrain the slaves had to travel to escape. Visit Bucktown General Store, where Harriet received her head wound that caused her to have headaches and visions. Travel along the Rt. 16 "Network To Freedom Highway." Visit Linchester Mills, where residents secretly helped fleeing slaves pass through the area.



FREDERICK DOUGLASS TOUR

(Easton and St. Michaels, MD.)

This guided tour traces the journey of abolitionist, orator and statesman, Frederick Douglass. Visit the Frederick Douglass Park, where he was born in 1818. Stop at the Talbot County Court House, where he was imprisoned and where slaves were auctioned. In St. Michael's, see the Mitchell House- the home of his sister Eliza, which provides a glimpse of the lifestyle of middle class free African Americans in the 19th Century. Visit "The Hill" – the oldest continuously inhabited settlement of freed blacks in the U.S. Visit the Bethel UMC and Asbury UMC, both dedicated on the same day by Frederick Douglass in 1878.

UNDERGROUND RAIILROAD TOUR OF BALTIMORE

This tour features significant places important to Maryland's African American history. You guided tour takes you through the city, to see Orchard Street Church – built in 1839 by former slave Truman Pratt. Some believe it was part of the Underground Railroad. See President Street Station – the site of the first bloodshed of the Civil War. Sharp Street Church is the oldest Black Congregation in Baltimore. Frederick Douglass sang in the church's choir from 1836-1838. Then, explore the National Great Blacks In Wax Museum. The first of its kind in the century, the museum presents such figures as Rosa Parks, Fredrick Douglass, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., and Harriet Tubman.

See the Fraunces Tavern in NYC's Financial District, which served as a hub for George Washington's spies during the Revolutionary War, and later became a shelter for enslaved persons passing through New York. Nearby, see the site of David Ruggle's Boarding House, a haven for black and white abolitionists. Visit Foley Square and the African Burial Ground National In Brooklyn Heights, see the Monument. Plymouth Church of the Pilgrims, where fugitive slaves sheltered in the church basement.


PHILADELPHIA AFRICAN AMERICAN HERITAGE TOUR

Delaware

UNDERGROUND RAILROAD of DELAWARE

Delaware's Underground Railroad is an intriguing story of courage, heroism, and personal sacrifice. A network of secret escape routes, safe houses, and prohibited assistance, the Underground Railroad provided illegal aid to black slaves fleeing from bondage. As the northernmost slave state, Delaware was considered the last stop to freedom and played a vital role in the Abolitionist Movement of the 18th century.

Start your day at the Delaware History Museum in Wilmington and get a glimpse of the First State's history and heritage. Visit the NEW Center for African American Heritage, then stop next door at the Old Town Hall, to observe jail cells once used to hold slaves and abolitionist meetings. Visit the Underground Railroad Exhibit in the New Castle Court House Museum. Enjoy an included lunch at Jessop's Tavern, a colonial tavern dating back to 1724. Next, travel to Dover to visit the home and plantation of John Dickinson, one of the founding fathers of the United States and signer of the Constitution. The Plantation features Dickinson's original 1740 brick home, reconstructed farm buildings and a log dwelling, surrounded by rich agricultural lands stretching down to the banks of the St. Jones River. Tours of the plantation enable visitors to compare and contrast lifestyles of the wealthy Dickinson family with those of tenants, poor whites, enslaved individuals & free blacks. 





As the northernmost slave state, Delaware stood as the last stop on the road to liberty and played a vital role in the Abolitionist Movement of the 19th century. Start your tour at the Seaford Museum and Woodland Ferry.
