HARRIET TUBMAN & THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD (EASTERN SHORE, MD)

Follow the inspiring life and legacy of Harriet Tubman on a guided journey through Maryland's Eastern Shore, where she was born enslaved and later escaped to freedom. Visit the Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad State Park and travel through Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge, experiencing the challenging landscape faced by those seeking freedom. Stop at the Bucktown General Store, where Harriet suffered the head injury that shaped her life, and travel along Route 16, known as the Network to Freedom Highway. Visit Linchester Mills, where local residents secretly aided escaping enslaved people.



Conclude at the National Great Blacks In Wax Museum, featuring lifelike figures such as Rosa Parks, Frederick Douglass, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., and Harriet Tubman.







Discover Delaware's vital role in the Underground Railroad, a network of secret routes and safe houses that helped enslaved people escape to freedom. Begin at the Delaware History Museum and the Center for African American Heritage, then visit Old Town Hall to see historic jail cells used for enslaved individuals and abolitionist meetings. Explore Historic New Castle, including the Underground Railroad Exhibit at the New Castle Court House Museum. Enjoy lunch at Jessop's Tavern, a colonial tavern dating back to 1724. In the afternoon, visit the John Dickinson Plantation in Dover, featuring the original 1740 brick home, reconstructed farm buildings, and grounds along the St. Jones River, offering insight into the lives of the Dickinson family, tenants, enslaved people, and free Blacks.

DELAWARE'S UNDERGROUND RAILROAD (3 Days)

As the northernmost slave state, Delaware stood as the last stop on the road to liberty and played a vital role in the Abolitionist Movement of the 19th century. Start your tour at the Seaford Museum and Woodland Ferry. In Dover, visit the Old State House, where Samuel Burris, a convicted African American Underground Railroad conductor, was sold into servitude and purchased with abolitionist funds.
